AFTER A NEAR-DEATH EXPERIENCE, HIDDEN HILLS RESIDENT STEVE WEBER SETS UP SHOP TO HELP OTHERS PROTECT THEMSELVES AND THEIR FAMILIES

t took a tragedy during the "trip of a lifetime" for Hidden Hills Resident, Steve Weber, to consider his mortality and just how quickly life can take a drastic turn. On the second day of a group dirt bike tour through Baja California back in 2007, Weber was injured. Immediately after, Weber was rushed to a Mexican hospital. "I was lying flat on a table where I lost consciousness," he recalls. Weber woke up four days later in a San Diego hospital after multiple surgeries and a medically induced coma.
